Certificate	<p><u>Teaching language is French only</u></p> <p>Level B1 is requested, with certificate :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DELF : diplôme d'études de langue française • DALF : diplôme approfondi de langue française • any certificate issued on behalf of any recognized French center) • any alternative qualifications (i.e. certificate issued by the Home University, language center, etc.) <p>In case that the student does not have an official document, the language proficiency report "attestation de langue française" in "documents to download" on the website, can be used as a proof of language qualification.</p> <p><u>Please note :</u> Certificates are only accepted if they state the level B1 or higher according to the CEFR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students that do not achieve an intermediate level of written and spoken French (B1 or above) may not be registered in the programs • Students have to send their certificate before July 15th. However if the required level is not reached in July, they can present it upon their arrival in September • Students whose mother tongue is French are exempted from this regulation

Health insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Convention students must register on the website Ameli.fr to benefit (free of charge) for their health insurance • ERASMUS and Swtzerland students must present an European Health Insurance Card (valid till the end of the year)
Insurances	<p><u>Accommodation insurance:</u> Compulsory for students, price range from 15 to 20€ (for the whole year).</p> <p><u>Liability Insurance for student life & private life:</u> This insurance, compulsory, will protect you from the financial consequences of physical, material and other damages that you may cause to someone else, both during your academic and personal activities as well as during your professional internships.</p> <p>Both accommodation and liability insurances can be taken Through the MEP or LMDE (health cover for students) which will be there at your arrival at the ENSA-MARSEILLE, or from any other insurance companies or banks that you could contact directly when you get to Marseille or before through internet. Aix-Marseille University set up a counter multiservices to help the international students in their administrative procedures. The counter is situated on the Campus Marseille Centre - Espace Yves-Mathieu (3, place Victor Hugo 13003 Marseille). Generally opened in September and October.
