	Once nominated, the student must fill out the application form and upload the required documents: passport, transcript of records, CV, cover letter, academic recommendation letter (issued by a professor or the international office) and proof of Spanish level for non-Spanish speaking countries.
Language	The minimum recommended level of Spanish is B1.
Visa	The student visa (temporary residency) is only required for a stay of more than 180 days (a consular letter will be issued along with the acceptance letter).
