**Subject: Face-to-face student academic mobility 2022.**

Dear Partners,

The Federal University of Rio Grande do Norte (UFRN) has announced the resumption of face-to-face academic activities as of March 28, 2022. We are therefore happy to be able to again receive students, researchers and staff from our partner institutions for academic activities on our campuses. We emphasize that any letter of acceptance for receiving foreign partners will only be issued after receipt of proof of vaccination with at least two doses of one of the COVID-19 vaccines.

Face-to-face student academic mobility activities will follow, for the year 2022, the calendar below. Interested students can already contact SRI to submit their applications.

**Deadline for Applications in 2022**

First Semester: January 15, 2022;

Second Semester: May 23, 2022.

**2022 Academic Calendar**

First Semester 2022

Classes start: March 28, 2022.

End of classes: July 30, 2022.

Second Semester 2022

Classes start: August 22, 2022.

End of classes: December 23, 2022.

To start the process of applying for mobility, the student must contact the mobility sector at his home institution, indicating interest in performing a period of studies at UFRN. After this

notification, the mobility sector at the home institution must appoint the student and formally notify us by e-mail of the student's name, the program to which he or she is applying, and the period of the mobility.

Once the nomination is received, UFRN's mobility sector will contact the student to provide him/her with the course syllabus, as well as the courses to be offered in the indicated period.

To finalize his application, the student must send to SRI / UFRN's Mobility Sector the application form, which can be downloaded at [sri.ufrn.br](http://sri.ufrn.br), a referral letter from the home institution, a copy of his passport, academic transcript, and proof of vaccination.
